

Overseas Highway Manifest

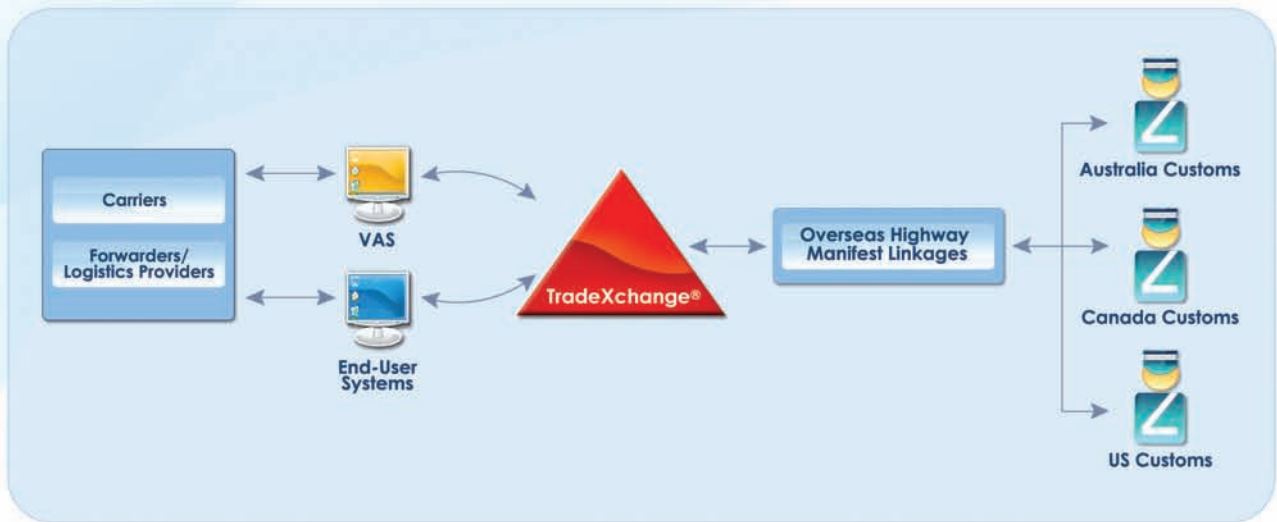
TradeXchange® Overseas Highway Manifest is an integrated manifest submission service providing the trade and logistics community with the ability to easily comply with recent customs regulations of certain countries that require the electronic submission of manifest data before the cargo arrives at the foreign country by air, sea or land.

Countries such as Australia, Canada and the United States have introduced risk management processes for unknown and high-risk shipments while at the same time facilitating the legitimate flow of goods and trade. Each country's respective regulatory body requires certain cargo, conveyance and importer data to be submitted before the goods arrive in the country. It is mandatory that this data be transmitted electronically. In some cases, carriers will need to obtain an "approval" from these regulatory bodies before the cargoes are allowed to be loaded at the port of loading in the exporting country.

TradeXchange® Overseas Highway Manifest enables TradeXchange® end-users and Value-Added Service (VAS) providers to report advance cargo and conveyance data electronically and securely to:

- The Australia Customs Service (ACS) Integrated Cargo System
- The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) Advance Commercial Information System
- The United States Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Advance Commercial Environment and Automated Manifest System
